

Your privacy is important to UralEcoMach Company. We developed this Privacy Notice to provide you with information on how we process your personal data when you prescribed your personal information, interact with our customer support specialists, visit <http://www.uralecomach.com/> or visit other UralEcoMach Company websites that include a link to this Privacy Notice.

We process your personal data in an appropriate and lawful manner, in accordance with applicable data protection regulations and the General Data Protection Regulation EU 2016/679 (the “GDPR”) which is in force as of 25 May 2018.

“Personal data” is information relating to an identified or identifiable natural person.

We will only collect and process personal data about you where we have lawful bases.

Lawful bases are:

- when you have given consent
- when we start negotiations for or entering into a contract to supply services to us. (where processing is necessary for the performance of a contract with you (e.g. to deliver the UralEcoMach Company services you have requested))
- when you filling in an enquiry form on the Website
- when you corresponding with us by post, phone email or otherwise when you apply for our services.

Information we collect about you from our website, we shall use this information:

- to administer our website and for internal operations, including troubleshooting and in order to keep our website safe and secure;
- to improve our website to ensure that content is presented in the most effective manner for you; and
- to ensure that content displayed on the website is presented in a user-friendly manner.

We have implemented measures in an effort to maintain the confidentiality of all personal information in our custody and control, including only providing access to personal information to employees and authorized person who require such information for the purposes described in this document.

We maintain administrative, technical and physical safeguards in an effort to protect against unauthorized access, use, modification and disclosure of personal information in our custody and control.

- **Right to Access and/or Take Your Data:** You can ask us for a copy of your personal data and can ask for a copy of personal data you provided in machine readable form.
- **Right to withdraw consent.** Where you have provided your consent to the collection, processing and transfer of your personal information for a specific purpose, you have the right to withdraw your consent for that specific processing at any time.
- **Right to move, copy or transfer your personal data (“data portability”).**
- **Right to have your personal data erased (the “right to be forgotten”).**

You have the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority at your home country. It has enforcement powers and can investigate compliance with data protection law.

- Personal details and include your first name, last name, nationality, country of residence, email address and phone number

LEGAL DISCLOSURES

USE OF COOKIES

A **“cookie”** is a string of information which assigns you a unique identifier that we store on your computer. Your browser then provides that unique identifier to use each time you submit a query to the Site. We use cookies on the Site to, among other things, keep track of services you have used, record registration information, record your user preferences, keep you logged into the Site, and track the pages you visit. Cookies help us understand how the Site is being used and improve your user experience.

A **“web beacon”** or **“pixel tag”** is tiny object or image embedded in a web page or email. They are used to track the number of users who have visited particular pages and viewed emails, and acquire other statistical data. They collect only a limited set of data, such as a cookie number, time and date of page or email view, and a description of the page or email on which they reside. Web beacons and pixel tags cannot be declined. However, you can limit their use by controlling the cookies that interact with them.
